Good Afternoon CBSD Parents/Guardians and Athletes:

The Central Bucks School District's Board of School Directors approved the revisions to the district's athletics health and safety plan as we prepare for the return to spring sports competition. The revised plan may be reviewed on [our website here](#). Student athletes in Central Bucks will abide by the following procedures concerning face coverings for spring sports:

- CBSD student-athletes are not required to wear a mask when actively engaged in training or competition. This includes volleyball.
- When entering and exiting a facility, student athletes will be masked.
- Student-athletes will need to maintain social distancing and wear a mask when seated/standing on the bleachers, bench, or dugout or while not actively engaged in training or competition.
- When traveling to another school, CBSD student athletes will be required to abide by the opponent's athletic health and safety plan, which may include mask wearing.
- In order to maximize opportunities for competition, athletic directors and coaches will work with student athletes to determine if masking will be required during a home contest where the opponent's health and safety plan requires masking in order to compete.

At the high school and middle school level, we will be welcoming back spectators from our CB community for all outdoor sporting events at no charge. For volleyball games, we will allow four spectators per student athlete, in keeping with the maximum occupancy guidelines outlined by the commonwealth. All spectators are required to wear a face covering at all times and maintain social distancing when attending events on our campuses. We will continue to live stream games in the stadium and gymnasium live on the NFHS Network
